JACK SHELLEY, War Correspondent (WHO Radio) from Des Moines



Jack Shelley was a war correspondent from Des Moines (WHO Radio). He visited a dozen different frontline divisions in the weeks just before, during, and after the Battle of the Bulge. Two 10-minute presentations will cover some of his experiences in the Eastern Theater of Operations, United States Army.
